Samuel Bible Summary.

All Israel would know that Samuel was the Lord's faithful Prophet, 1 Sam 3:20.

God raised up Samuel, as a prophet & judge & the one who would anoint the 1st two kings of His Kingdom, Israel. Samuel was obedient to God, as he served the disobedient Israelites. He was bold & spoke God's truth without fear of man, 1 Sam. 12 & was faithful to pray. We should all seek a heart like Samuel's.

Samuel was a deliverer, that called Israel to repentance when the Philistines were able to take the ark of the covenant & the Lord intervened mightily on Israel's behalf & gave victory over the massive Philistines, affirming the authority of Samuel as an ordained leader, while showing a divine protection & blessing for God's people, when they place their confidence in Him & live in obedience to their covenant.

God had fulfilled all Israel's needs, as He had promised, but they wanted to be like their neighbors, which birthed one of the peoples greatest mistakes ever, which was their desire to be led into peace & battles, by a human King, 1 Samuel 8:20.

God called for Israel to be different, but they rejected His Theocratic Kingship & rule & even with all His warnings, through Samuel, about how a king would enslave them & take all from them, they still wanted to be like the other nations, who had human kings ruling over them? So Israel's sinful desire for a human king was allowed, as God told Samuel to give them what they asked for & in 1100 B.C. they got their 1st of 42 future Kings, some were good, some were bad, none were God & we will touch on a few of them good & bad, in the upcoming pages, such as the 1st two, anointed by Samuel, king Saul & then king David.

Before Samuel anointed the 1st king, he needed to be sure that the people would maintain a covenant with God, so he called the people to repentance & renewal of their allegiance to God, on the inauguration of the king. By establishing a kingship via a covenant renewal, the king was not to be autonomous in his own authority; but was to be subject to the laws of God & the words of the prophet, Samuel 10:25; 12:23. The king would be an instrument of the Lord's rule & the people would continue to recognize God, as their ultimate Sovereign ruler, Samuel, 12:14-15.

Now Saul was an impressive young man among the Israelites, so they chose him as their 1st king, 1 Sam. 9:2, even though he wasn't God's choice, he now had a chance to please God & establish a permanent reign in Israel, 1 Sam. 13:13, but he was

foolish & in time lost it all, due to disobedience to God. Saul disobeyed God, 1 Sam. 13:13 & built a monument to himself, 1 Sam. 15:12, proving to be a bad leader, who was rejected by God, 1 Sam. 15:27, so God told Samuel that He had chosen a new king, a shepherd boy named David, 1 Sam. 16:1-13.

David was anointed by God, as a man after God's own heart & yet still served king Saul, as a musician & warrior & God was with him, 1 Sam 18:1-7. Saul had become violently jealous & wanted David dead, causing David to live in hiding. Soon after, Saul was killed in battle, Israel now had a season of victory & blessing, under David. But like Saul, over time David also made a grave error & caused a young married woman, Bathsheba, to commit adultery & become pregnant & then ended up murdering her husband & marrying her, to cover up the adultery, 2 Sam. 11. When confronted, by the prophet Nathan, David repented, but the damage was done & the consequences of sin are severe. First Bathsheba miscarried David's child & then his family started falling apart & engaging in sexual abuse, murder, deceit & betrayal, 2 Sam. 13-21.

So 1 & 2 Samuel compare the rise & fall of King Saul, a man-pleaser & King David, a God-pleaser & demonstrates the foolishness of disobedience to God, as well as the humility, faith & reward of a life lived to honor God. Saul disobeyed God & came to a tragic end 1 Sam. 31:4. Now David had great faith & as a small, young lad, defeated a giant named Goliath, 1 Sam. 17:4. David showed great humility, even in his dealings with Saul, who wanted to murder him, 1 Sam. 24:5-15 & 1 Sam. 26:17-20, but as humble as he was, he was not exempt from sinful disobedience, 1 bad decision caused his life to come crashing down, yet, he was still chosen by God to have his kingdom established 1 Sam 7:12 & it was written that the Savior Jesus, would come from the line of David, 2 Sam. 7.

Like all people, Samuel, Saul & David all had times of disobedience. Samuel was blessed & he was used by God in powerful ways, 1 Sam. 4:1; 1 Sam. 7, yet allowed his own sons to live in sin & to pervert the ways of God. David obeyed God & his early days were filled with faith & victory, but then he commits adultery & the blessings disappear. Saul had a promising start & then the Spirit of God came down on him, 1 Sam. 11:6, as he suffered divine rejection when he rejected God's word, 1 Sam. 15:26. Saul went from disobedient, to delusional, to deranged. Saul's greatest character flaw was his desire to please people, over his conviction to obey God, his sin was due to; He was afraid of what the people thought, 1 Sam. 15:26.

The 2nd book of Samuel picks up after Saul's death, which David grieved, as He is a humble man who even grieves the death of his enemies. David experiences some success & blessing & the tribes of Israel ask him to unify them, so the first thing he does as king is conquers Jerusalem & establish it as Israel's capital city & renames it Zion. From there, David continues to win many battles & expand Israel's territory. David had made Jerusalem the political capital of Israel & wanted to make it their religious capital as well, so he had the ark of the covenant moved into the city. David asks God, if he can build a new temple for Him, God says to David, I'm going to build you a dynasty & God makes a promise to David that, from his royal line, there will come a king, who will set up an eternal kingdom.

In his end, David's son Absalom hatches a plot to oust his father from power & launches a rebellion & David is forced to flee & hide. The rebellion ends when David's son is murdered, which breaks David's heart & so his last days find him on his throne, as a broken man, wounded by the sad consequences of his own sin.

Thank God always, for everything. Always praise God, for being God & being good & unchanging. We must show gratitude to God & praise Him for who He is, we must appreciate His love, power, goodness, strength & justice. God is our helper, as a parent, you may be feeling anxious about your child, but remember that you are only a steward & that God is the father of your child. Go in prayer to God & ask Him to take care of your children & when you are not able to get through to them, God will help, all you need to do is ask.

God wants us to be different, not like the unbelievers, He wants us to live according to his Word, so we need to stay focused on His word to overcome the pressures of the world. Let's stick with God's word & learn how wonderfully He can start a new work in our lives, at any moment.

Think about what could happen if Christian leaders simply did what Samuel, Moses & Joshua did? Just listened to the Lord, received their instruction from God, assembled a godly team, communicated in God's way, without personal opinions, learned beliefs & unfounded inferences, while praying for all people. David's heart for God shined & when he didn't know what to do, he spent time with God, he honored & respected all. He was a man of integrity & he let God promote him at the right time, he was never in a hurry. God will accomplish what He wants to in our life, if we have the heart of David, loving God and loving people.
