103 (A) Led by Beliefs or Truth

Let's get down & dirty, so we can get lifted up & cleansed properly.

What's your 1st reaction when someone says something bad about your mom? Maybe calls your mom the "B" word, what do you think of that person? So, have you ever called anyone a bad name? yeah but, but what? So, you believe in free will for you, but want it regulated for others?

Have you ever said that you hated anyone? Did you know that God says hatred of another, is equal to murder in the heart?

So you believe that you have the right to say derogatory things about others, that you may not like, but other people don't have the free will right to dislike you, or yours, or say things, true, or not, about you & yours.

You might as well learn & accept that not everyone is going to accept you & everyone has the right to dislike you & your mother & to call your mother every name in the book & according to the king of creation, you still need to love them, as God commands, not asks or recommends, but commands, as God said love all people, not just those that like, or love you, or do things your way, or for you, as anyone can do that, but if you claim to be a Christian, of God, or loved by God, then the Spirit of God & Christ lives within you & should be operating through you & they could care less about what another says about you, or your mother, as long as you react with the love, joy & wisdom, of He who you claim lives within you, i.e. be the better person by role modeling who lives within you e.g. I am sorry you feel that way, you may even be right, but I still have no bad feelings towards you & your Given rights to dislike others & to act as you do, so thank you for your observation.

Be of the same mind toward one another; do not be haughty in mind, but associate with the lowly. Do not be wise in your own estimation. Never repay evil for evil to anyone. Respect what is right in the sight of all people. If possible, so far as it depends on you, be at peace with all people. Never take your own revenge, beloved, but leave room for the wrath of God, for it is written; Vengeance is Mine, I will repay, says the Lord. If

your enemy is hungry, feed him, if he is thirsty, give him a drink; for in so doing you will heap burning coals on his head. Do not be overcome by evil, but overcome evil with good Romans 9-21. God does not need our un-Christion evil pride, anger, or vengeance, to overtake us in a true moment of testing of our love for God & His Ways.

Learn to take control of & turn these heated moments, where the enemy is testing you, into Christian moments, while learning that if you want free will, including being able to preach the Gospel, then you must accept the fact that God gave every human being free will, to say & think what they want, about who they want, with the only repercussions coming from Him & he does care of every bad thing against you, or from you & will deal with it in His way & His time & vengeance against the evils against you will come.

Now even though God commands that you love all, as He loves you, you do not need to like, or condone all things, but if you want free will in your life then you must respect that others also have the right to feel what they feel, because again, it is supposed to be Christ that lives within us & Christ is the one who gives free will & if you want it for you, but want to limit others, then that is not living in the name above all names.
