

### **103 (B) Abortion; Who else it may harm.**

As a Christian, I do not condone, nor advocate for the act of abortion, or those who have, perform, or lobby for them; though I also do not hate, nor judge them & I do pray for & love them as God commands, as I do believe in God's laws & I do believe that we have the God given right to accept & model His truth & love & accept our future reward, or deny Him & accept the future consequences.
