

104 (E) Truly the Son of God

Referring to the horrible death He faced, Jesus fell on his face & prayed, Father, may this cup be taken from me, yet not My will, but Your will be done, Matt. 26:39. Jesus also said, I tell you, the Son can do nothing, by Himself, unless He sees the Father doing it, for what the Father does, these things the Son also does, in the same way. For the Father loves the Son & shows Him all things that He is doing & just as the Father raises the dead, so the Son also gives life to whom He wishes.

For not even the Father judges anyone, but He has given all judgment to the Son, so that all will honor the Son, just as they honor the Father. The one who does not honor the Son does not honor the Father, I say to you, the one who hears My word & believes Him who sent Me, has eternal life & does not come into judgment, but has passed out of death into life, as a time has arrived, when the dead will hear the voice of the Son of God & those who hear will live. For just as the Father has life in Himself, so He gave to the Son also to have life in Himself & He gave Him authority to execute judgment, as He is the Son of Man.

Do not be amazed at this; for a time is coming when all who are in the tombs will hear His voice & will come out, those who did the good deeds; to a resurrection of life, those who committed the bad deeds; to a resurrection of judgment. I can do nothing on My own, as I hear, I judge & My judgment is righteous, as I do not seek My own will, but the will of Him who sent Me, John 5:19-30.

Some think that Jesus' statement; I & my Father are one, is Jesus stating that He is God, yet the Father knows things that Jesus doesn't? & the Greek word for one, does not imply being a part of the same substance, as seen in John 17:11 Where Jesus prays to God, that they all may be one; as you, Father, are in me, and I in you, that they also may be one in us; Jesus is asking to be of one unified purpose, not one substance.

Jesus proclaimed, I & my Father are one, because Jesus does the works of the Father & when the people wanted to stone him, Jesus asked why & they said, you claim to be God & Jesus said; Is it not written in your Law, I have said you are gods, John 10:30-34. Jesus refers to the judges who teach God's divine Law, as gods, Psalm 82:6. The Torah refers to Judges as gods, as they are agents of God's law, not because they are God.

The Jewish Scriptures often refers to agents of God, as a god. God even told Moses, I have made you like God, to Pharaoh, Exodus 7:1, as Moses was God's word, to Pharaoh.

The Bible never claims that Jesus is God, but rather God's representative, delivering God's word. For I did not speak of My own accord, but the Father who sent Me, commands Me what to say & how to say it, John 12:49. Jesus said, I go to the Father who is greater than I, John 14:28.

Jesus also says, the Father is the only true God. This is life eternal, that they might know You, the only true God, as well as your son Jesus Christ, whom You have sent, John 17:3.

Jesus said to Mary, touch me not; for I am not yet ascended to My Father. Tell my brethren, I ascend unto My & your Father & to My God, & your God, John 20:17.

After the crucifixion, Jesus still calls the Father, my God. But never does the Father call Jesus, or the spirit God. The bible does not consider Jesus to be equal with God, even after the ascension, Paul says that Jesus is subordinate to God.

The bible claims that God bestowed authority upon Jesus, but never the other way around. For there is one God & one mediator between God & men, Christ Jesus, I Tim. 2:5.

Blessed be the God & Father of our Lord Jesus, I Peter 1:3. Jesus offered up both prayers & supplications with crying & tears to the One who was able to save Him from death & although He was a Son, He learned obedience to the Father from the things He suffered, Hebrews 5:8.

Would God, beg & cry to God, to save Himself?

The Godhead, mentioned 3 times in the bible, means God, i.e., deity, divine being, supreme being, divinity, immortal, creator, etal & to which man adds to God's deity, by inferring that Godhead means more than one, saying that if God calls Himself the Godhead, then there must be a hierarchy of God? Which comes from man's inferences, or misunderstanding, not God.

As we are the offspring of God, we should not think that the Godhead is like unto gold, or silver, or stone, graven by art & man's devices, Acts 17:29. For in Christ dwells the fullness of the Godhead, the full spirit of God, bodily & we have been made complete in Christ, who is the head over every ruler & authority, Colossians 2:9-10.

This should not confuse us to the fact of who God says Jesus is, as He is the High Priest Hebrews 4:14 & Son of God, whom God has granted fullness of authority too; but still, God alone, is God.

I am not ashamed to proclaim the power of God, which leaves us all without excuse; as when they knew God, they glorified Him not, nor were they thankful, but vain in imaginations & their foolish hearts were darkened, professing themselves to be wise & they became fools, Romans 1:20-22.

Neither God, nor Jesus ever claimed that Jesus was God, nor ever said that we are to worship Christ. So ask yourself? When God said, this is my Son, in whom I am well pleased, talking about Jesus being His begotten Son; which God & Jesus are good with; why isn't man good with Jesus just being the Holy Son of God? just as God said. Why must men call Jesus God & make God's spirit a separate man & God & then wonder why so many people pick & choose, what to make God's in their lives, when God specifically never intended anyone, or anything to be God, except for Him, our One God?

Maybe some have been taught to need more than one god for the things in their life?

There is one Father God All Mighty & one Son & High Priest, Jesus Christ, who does carry all authority of His Father, as He delivers the Father's words & is in whom saved believers have been granted eternal life with the Father & Son, through the love & blood sacrifice of the Son.

The Son is our perfect example of how we are to worship the Father & to love all our brothers & sisters through His perfect love, ordained by God.

Even with everything that God says & Jesus teaches, man will go: yes, all that is true, because God said it is & God is truth, but God is also 3, with God being God & the son being god & the spirit being god, because centuries after Christ' ministry, the church bishops & councils decided that's how their god should be & that's who many still choose to follow today & I will continue to pray for all people, that they will receive the ears to hear, the One true God, when He Himself claims, I am One & I alone am your God!

The choice is yours follow what & who God says He is, or follow what man needed God to be, to make Him confusing, so that people would have to have the religious leaders, to explain their confusing trinity, forcing them into church to learn about the confusion, even though it is said, that God is not the God of confusion, but of Peace.

At the least we can be sure that one day we will absolutely know the full truth of how our God & Jesus have worked together, to bring us unto them, to worship & serve them together, throughout eternity & it will be my pleasure to serve with you then, just as it is now, as even in our differences we are serving the one true living God of creation together, even if not completely realizing it.
