Joshua is a story of how God reclaimed a portion of His world back from the powers of evil people & their false gods. It tells how He called His people to serve in His army, under Joshua, to take Canaan out of the hands of the idolatrous Canaanites. Joshua was God's chosen, to complete Moses' work & establish Israel in the promised land, as he was a faithful leader of God's army.

As the leader of the Israelites, Joshua assures us that God rewards obedience. He was courageous through faith, as He followed the orders given to Him as he led God's people, after Moses' death, into the promised land. First off 10 spies went in to check out Canaan & saw giant men & fortresses & became fearful & doubtful, but Joshua & Caleb saw the enemies' lack of God's protection & prepared for battle. We all will be faced with battles that require great faith & like Joshua, we have the ability, through the Holy Spirit, to use faith & courage to see our power, with God on our side & as if God is for us, who can be against us? For our struggle is not against flesh & blood, but against the rulers, authorities, & dark powers of this world & against the spiritual forces of evil, in the heavenly realms, Ephesians 6:12. Joshua was told to be strong & courageous, from God, Moses et al, as every battle is won, not by the hands of men, but in the strength of the Lord! As if we try to win our battles by our strengths, we will always lose, but if we see, how God gives us power against our enemies, we would become mighty in battle. Not by might nor by power, but by Spirit, says the Lord, Zechariah 4:6. Fighting in the Spirit through prayer will demolish & destroy all enemies' influence over our lives. So Joshua followed God's orders & conquered Canaan, including the huge fortress of Jericho.

This is a story of conquest & fulfillment for the people of God. After years of slavery in Egypt & 40 years in the desert, the Israelites were finally allowed to enter the land promised to their fathers. The Lord's triumph over the Canaanites showed the world that the God of Israel, is the one true living God, whose claim on the world is absolute. It was also a warning to the nations that the kingdom of God would disinherit those that opposed it, giving place in the earth only to those who acknowledge & serve the Lord, as it gave notice of the destiny of mankind.

Lot divided the land, among the tribes of Israel & Joshua gave this message; Choose whom you will serve, be it the gods your fathers served, or the gods of the pagans, but I & my house will serve the Lord God Almighty. Then the people said, we will not forsake the Lord, He brought us out of the bondage of Egypt & did great miracles in our sight & preserved us among all the people through whom we came. The Lord did cast out all the opposition in the land & so we will serve Him.

Joshua told them, if you forsake the Lord & serve strange gods, then He will bring evil upon & consume you, Joshua told them, you are witnesses against yourselves, that you have chosen to serve God, so put away any strange gods & bow your hearts to the Lord God of Israel, Josh. 24:15-24. Keep the Book of the Law on your lips; meditate on it day & night, be careful to do everything written in it, then you will be prosperous & successful, Joshua 1:8. At the end of life, Joshua encouraged the people to choose God over all, as he did all that God had commanded Moses. Under Joshua's leadership the Lord's promises to Israel were fulfilled, Joshua 21:45. Wouldn't it be good to see all God's promises fulfilled in our lives? God hasn't called us to live sorrowful, defeated lives, but for us to rise up & conquer, through faith, as without faith it is impossible to please God, as anyone who comes to Him must believe He exists & that He rewards those who earnestly seek Him, Hebrews 11:6.

Stay focused as a warrior of Christ, taking steps of faith, fighting the good fight, & receiving the favor of God, for I have commanded; be strong & courageous, do not be afraid, or discouraged, for the Lord your God will be with you always, Joshua 1:9. Ask yourself, are my words & actions reflecting faith in God i.e., Lord I pray that you teach us to be content & satisfied with all that you have done for us, as we see that all's this world has to offer is heartache & disobedience & the sooner that we rely on you, the sooner we will find the peace from knowing that all is yours, including us & the only thing we truly need to make it out of this world & into yours, is a deeper relationship with you & a heart that says, yes I love, forgive & pray for everyone, as I am not of this world, as my home is with & in Christ.

Let's discuss something priceless, "Forgiveness", many of us receive it much better than we give it, so let's take a moment to think about a true forgiver. In Luke 23:34 an innocent man is hanging on a cross, for no wrongdoing & is being poked, prodded, spit on, as He hangs in deep pain, bleeding & dying in shame, to which He hollers "Father, forgive them. for they know what they do" As we were killing Him, through our sins, He was praying for us? & yet we find it hard to forgive those who've wronged us, or stepped on our toes, or upset our idea of fair play?

On another level, in the story of Cinderella a young girl is treated horribly by her evil family, when asked about how she was treated, she replies, "They treat me as well as they are able"? Is it possible to live with such peace, as to be able to forgive this way? In Math. 19:26, Jesus looked at them & said, "With man this is impossible, but with God all things are possible." Make sure nobody pays back wrong for wrong,

always strive to do what is good, rejoice always, pray continually, give thanks in all things, for this is God's will for you in Christ, 1Thess. 5:15-18.

To maintain a steady heart in an unsteady world, we need to know that we are & will be upheld, as God upholds us by His divine, unshakable love. Those upheld by God know who to fear, who to obey & who their soul longs for. The fears of the present fade, due to the light of his future. He is not afraid of bad news, his heart is firm, trusting in the Lord, his heart is steady, he will not be afraid, his light will dawn in the darkness, until the darkness is gone, his adversity will end, his enemies will fall, he will triumph. Even when he is assailed by trials & sorrows, as those against God are prospering, he knows that their comfort is short-lived & his is never-ending. Blessed is he who fears the Lord, Psalm 112:1.

Be gracious, when others would be unkind, be merciful when others would be cold & unforgiving, be righteous when others indulge & rebel, Psalm 112:4.

We have faced real fears, but one rises above all, the justice of our righteous Lord, as before we fear how life can harm us, we ought to fear the one who can destroy us, Mt 10:28, yet this fear is a great thing, as those who fear God, find a refuge & friend beyond belief.
