EZRA bible Summary Study.

The Book of Ezra, with the Book of Nehemiah, are the final chapters of the historical narrative of the Hebrew Bible. Ezra was a priest, in the line of Aaron the chief priest under Moses, to the Israelites, during & in the return from the exile, he was a skilled scribe & a great leader among Biblical heroes, via his teaching of the Torah (1st 5 bible books of Moses).

Even in Israel's darkest hour, Jeremiah had prophesied that God would use Israel's time in exile for their benefit, winning back their hearts.

Ezra covers the return of exiles, after 70 yrs., to Israel, from Babylonia as God had promised & the rebuilding/ dedication of the new Temple in Jerusalem, which was halted by those who did not want to see Israel gain strength back again, but via the prophets Haggai & Zechariah, God encouraged the people & their faith & enthusiasm were reestablished showing what it means to stay committed to a task, as these volunteers on the temple dealt with active opposition & long delays on the project, yet, held onto their passion to rebuild & keep the vision alive & the work of the temple was completed, after 20 yrs.

Ezra was also given the struggle of purifying the Jews, from inter-marriage with non-Jews & their pagan religious practices & so 60 yrs. later, when he returned with another group of exiles, he found the temple restored to glory, but he also found that God's people, the people of Israel, including the priests & the Levites, had not kept themselves separate from the foreigners & their pagan practices & had taken some of them as wives & had mixed the holy race with those around them, Ezra 9:1, placing the future of Israel in danger.

Deeply burdened & humbled, Ezra began weeping & praying for the people, 9:3–15, which moved them deeply & he called for the exiles to gather in the city, where he told the men to separate from their foreign wives & children & the people obeyed, confessed their sins to God & even re-established the practices of tithing & observing the sabbath, as Ezra was able to lead them back to renewing their covenant with God, while separating from the pagans.

Ezra was devoted to God's word & he gained knowledge & wisdom through intense study of the scriptures, as God's commands became the guiding force of his life, he set a pattern for the rest of God's people, through his spiritual zeal & dedication to prayer & fasting. He was an intercessor, seeking

the Lord's mercy for himself & others, as he knew the power of confession & repentance to reawaken faith, which he longed for the Jewish people to experience, as he had a heart to restore worship life to the people.

The book of Ezra reminds us that discouragement & fear are two of the biggest obstacles to fulfilling God's plan for our lives, as we can expect opposition from unbelievers & spiritual forces in doing the Lord's work, but if we prepare our faith, we can become fully equipped to face opposition. God can & did even set the hearts of & use foreign kings to fulfill his plans, showing His sovereignty over the world & leaders, as He will always accomplish his purpose.

Through Ezra's leadership, Israel would learn to rebuild their lives on the Word of God, rediscovering their identity in God's promises, God's law & stories of God's goodness & faithfulness, which God's people should be clinging to.

In the Hebrew Bible, Ezra & Nehemiah were once one book & can still be read that way & even the prophets Haggai & Zechariah ministered during this same time & can be studied alongside Ezra, as they all emphasize the restoration of, God's followers, physical & spiritual life.

Ezra encourages us to stand up for our faith. He knew that the Torah had been neglected by many during the Jewish exile. So in Jerusalem, he boldly spoke up for God's Laws, as Ezra's focus was on studying, applying & teaching God's word to others, surely a discipline that all Christians would be wise to adopt, as submitting our lives into God's care means we can find peace, even in situations that might at times look bleak, as the more we align with God, the less distractions & resistance will hold us back from what we're called to do.

Doing what God calls us to, even when it inconveniences us, or makes us uncomfortable, shows a true desire to please the Lord & Ezra, reminds us of some powerful ways to worship God, through His practices of prayer, Ezra 9:5-15, fasting, Ezra 8:21, 23 & confession, Ezra 10:1-15, which helped to revive the soul of the Israelite nation, just as it can with us as well.

How about the new documentary Wild Kingdom? Or maybe the Broadway musical Oliver? How about spy film's e.g. Dr. No, or the sci-fi Outer Limits, or the drama of the Fugitive?

Maybe you were more light hearted liking sitcoms like the Dick Van Dyke Show? Phil Silvers show, or My Favorite Martian? Or how about them Beverly Hillbillies, or the new Peter Sellers comedy movie- The Pink Panther, or did you like the talk shows & guests like on the Judy Garland Show, or were you more of a game show aficionado with Let's Make a Deal?

What other shows or entertainment can you think of from this period?

Something else to think about from this time was that minimum wage was \$1.25 & the average household income in the U.S. was about \$84 a week. So can you think of what your families socioeconomic status was? Who worked & what were they able to supply for the family? Do you recall prices of items you liked & purchased, or which was purchased for you?
