102 B. A good way to study the Bible.

Ask yourself & write down, what kind of changes are you looking for in your thinking & life?

Are you burdened with anger, loneliness, depression, addiction, sin? Ask google; what does the Bible say about (?) & write down all verses in the bible that talks about your issue, or questions e.g. "being lost" "needing help", "how do I?"? Start studying these verses, word for word & let the Bible's teaching & discerning power work with & for you, by you being completely open to any possible changes as you truly study, as often as you can, while looking for these words to come alive, in your heart, mind & soul.

Try to set up routine study times & be sure to not let all the excuses, that will come up, to stop you from working to better your thinking & life. It will also help to study at least 5-15 in the morning to get your mind & day started with a good healthy mindset & to write some verses down on index cards to carry with you, to read throughout the day, when the enemy shows up, which he will, as he comes to kill, steal & destroy all our peace & hopes.

It's important to remember just reading the Bible will not do much for you, but studying & believing in it, allows God to take control of your burdens, showing you the rewards of replacing them with wisdom, which will bring Him & His word alive in your life & then you will start to understand the true healing power of the word of God & realize that knowing God may not make life easier at this moment, but it will make it better.

So your goal shouldn't start as just wanting to read the whole bible, but to study God's word, not seeking to know everything, but to know more

each day, than the day before. Don't waste valuable time trying to pronounce names that you cannot, or making things important that are not & don't worry about if you pray properly, as when you pray it's about what's in your heart, not what comes out of your mouth. The Lords prayer does give us an outline for praying, showing that we should acknowledge God's holiness & great power & thank Him for the power in the name & blood of His Son, allowing us to be close to Him, as we pray for His will to be done, through us, as we pray for our leaders, families, country etc. & always finishing up "in the powerful holy name of Jesus Christ our Lord"

Practice praying out loud, as again there is really not a wrong way to pray, except in just asking things for your own benefit, as God already knows your wants & needs & will supply them on His time, as you learn to humble yourself by lifting others needs & wants, above your own.

Blessings in your studies & be sure to remember that you are just as worthy as all Gods children, of all His blessings. As in His eyes we are all equally worthy of all He has to teach & all He has to give.
