

104 17. WHO DO YOU SAY I AM.

We pray that the God of our Lord Jesus Christ, Christ= the Anointed, or Chosen One, may instill in us, a spirit of wisdom & revelation, in our knowledge of Him & that He will lead us to discerning the words of Jesus, as well as into testing & proving all that we have been taught by men, to be sure that we are following God, as God intends & not following possible false misinterpretations, or mistaken inferences of Godly men, who believed & are teaching what they learned from Godly men, while not taking time to test & prove what they are sharing; as again, hearing, learning, believing & teaching, is not equal to testing & proving & doesn't prove truth..

Over 3900 years had passed since Adam & before God sent His Son Jesus Christ to earth in the flesh. An angel came to Mary & later told Joseph as well, that his fiancé, Mary, a virgin, would bear a son & to stay with her & to name the boy Jesus, (Jesus= God saves) for He shall save God's people from their sins, Matthew 1:21.

740 years before Christ was born, the prophet Isaiah foresaw it & told the world, in Isaiah 9:6; for unto us a child is born, unto us a Son is given & the government shall be upon his shoulder & His name shall be called Wonderful, Counselor, el gibbor- the mighty God (el gibbor can translate to "mighty hero" as well), the everlasting Father, the Prince of Peace, Isaiah 9:6.

Please be careful here, as with all God's words, and don't just add that He is the All Mighty God & claim it is truth, when it only says that He will be "called these things by men", as many did & will call Him mighty God

& many other things, not all good & He was mighty & had all the attributes of & mediated directly for God, so it is not wrong to refer to Him as God, when speaking to, or mediating with God, as we reach The Father & All Mighty God through Him & many times when Jesus the Christ, or anointed one & God are referred to in the same sentence, it is referring to Jesus & God, not Jesus as God.

So we should understand that Jesus is the Son of the All Mighty God & was not literally, everything that everyone called Him, or else you may have to say that He was just a good man, as many called Him that too, but we know they were mistaken, yet it still does not give us the right to pick & choose which inferences that we will claim as true & which as false, as all inferences are wrong, when dealing with a very specific God, so don't read between the lines, test & prove what every line mean in God's word.

Yeshua, Yehoshua, or Joshua, to which the English translation is Jesus & comes from the Greek iesous, though the translation is not as important, as who it represents, as what matters, is that Jesus Christ, is Lord & sent by our God, to be the world's savior, regardless of language & translation, so that all who call upon & believe in His name, will be saved, Romans 10:13, as His name translates back to the Father, as the name Jesus mean's "God is salvation, or God saves", but be careful not to infer here that this says Jesus is God, just because His name speaks of who His Father is, as God & the true Creator & Savior of Creation.

Some other names & characteristics of the Son of God are as follows: Jesus asked His disciples, who do you say I am & the Apostle Peter said, You are the Christ, the Son of God, Mathew 15:16. Jesus is called; The Lion of the Tribe of Judah, Rev. 5:5. He will be great & will be called the Son of the most High.

The Lord God will give him the throne of his father David (genealogical) & He will reign over Jacob's descendants forever; His kingdom will never end, Luke 1:32–33.

He is our sufficiency, our victory & our identity, as there is nothing that we can face, that He can't handle. He is our Advocate against sins, 1 John 2:1. The Author & Perfecter of our Faith, Hebrews 12:2, He is the King of kings, Matthew 28:18, He is the Bread of Life, John 6:35, The Beloved Son of God, Matt. 3:17. He is the Bridegroom of His bride, Jerusalem, Matt. 9:15, the Chief Cornerstone & the Stone the builders rejected, Psalm 118:22. He is Our Deliverer, from wrath, 1 Thess. 1:10. He is Faithful & True, Revelation 19:11.

He is the Good Shepherd, who lays down his life, John 10:11. The Great High Priest who has passed through the heavens, Hebrews 4:14. The Head of the Church, Ephesians 1:22. A Holy Servant, Acts 4:29-30. Immanuel (God with us, via His spirit), Is. 7:14. An Indescribable Gift, 2 Cor. 9:15. A just Judge, of the living & the dead, Acts 10:42. Lord of lords, Rev. 17:14. The Lamb of God, John 1:29. He is The Light of the World; that whoever follows will never walk in darkness, John 8:12.

The Lord of All, the name above all names, Philemon, 2:9. Mediator, between God & men, 1 Timothy 2:5. The Messiah, the Christ, John 1:41. The Mighty One, the Lord & Savior, Isaiah 60:16. He is the One Who Sets Free, John 8:36. Our Great Hope, 1 Timothy 1:1. Our Peace, Ephesians 2:14. Our Redeemer, Job 19:25. The Risen Lord, 1 Corinthians 15:3-4. The Spiritual Rock, 1 Cor. 10:4. The Atoning sacrifice for sin, 1 John 4:10. A Savior, from the city of David, Luke 2:11. The Son of Man, Luke 19:10. Son of the Most High, Luke 1:32. Resurrection & the Life, John 11:25. The Door that if any enters by, will be saved, John 10:9. The true Vine, whose Father is the vinedresser, John 15:1. The Truth, that will set you free,

John 8:32. The Victorious One, Rev. 3:21. Jesus rightly claims; I am the way, the truth & the life, no one comes to, the Father, except through me, John 14:6.
