104.25. PREDESTINATION OR ADOPTION

Blessed be the God & Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who hath blessed us with all spiritual blessings in heavenly places in Christ. According as he hath chosen us in Him, before the foundation of the world, that we should be Holy & without blame before Him.
