## 104.26. I WANT MINE NOW.

Parable of the Prodigal son. Luke 15:11-32.

There was a Jewish father with 2 sons & the youngest asked for an early inheritance, to which the father agreed & divided his estate. The youngest then went away & used the money for sinful, self-indulgent living. His money ran out & famine overtook the country. In a desperate attempt to survive, the son worked feeding pigs to which the average Jew would rather die than do.

While he fed the pigs, he even wanted to eat their food, as he had none of his own. In his desolate state, the son came to his senses & realized that his father had food & all that he needed. So The son went back home hoping to be hired as a servant, as he knew he no longer had the right to be recognized as a son, due to his rebellion.

When the father saw the son, he received him back with great joy & celebration, the father kissed his son & gave him the best robe, a ring of authority & restoration to his place in the family, he also placed sandals on his feet & commanded the fattened calf be killed, which was reserved for special occasions.

God's love for us & our love for God is what should always motivate us, in everything, as God is waiting with open arms, ready to take any back into His love & Kingdom, regardless of what the person has done to push themselves away from Him, as there is nothing that He will not forgive & wash away, NOTHING! to have a meaningful relationship with any & every single one, of His children.
